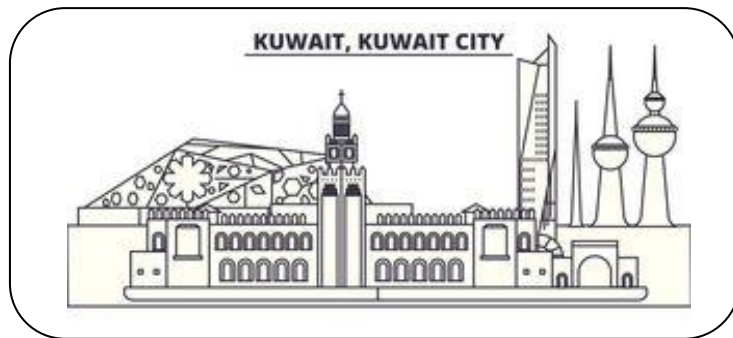

Penguins are birds with black and white feathers. They have wings, but they can't fly like many other birds. Penguins live near salt water. They have special part in their bodies that pushes the salt out of their beaks. A group of penguins that lives together is called " a colony ". Penguins find their food in the water too. They eat fish, shrimps, squids and other forms of sea life which **they** catch with their beaks and swallow while swimming.

Most people think that penguins live in very cold places like Antarctica, but they also live on the coasts of south America , Africa and Australia. They spend half of their lives on land and the other half in the sea. The largest living penguin is called 'emperor penguin'. It's about 1.1 m tall and weighs 35 kg. 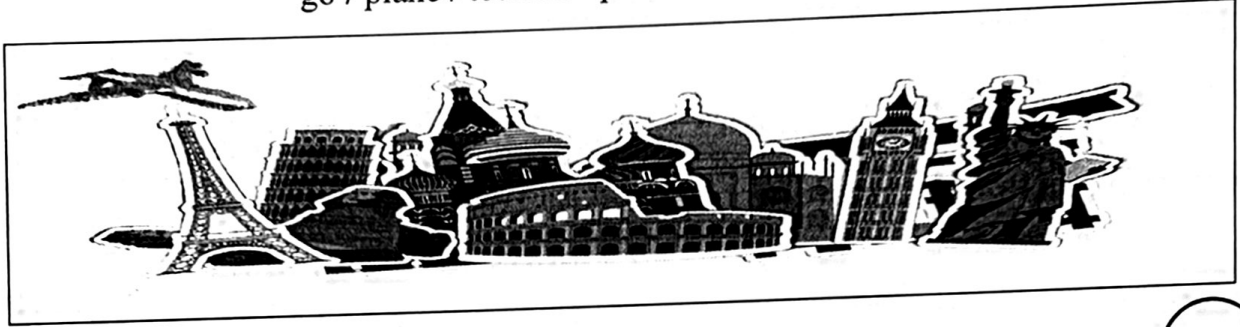

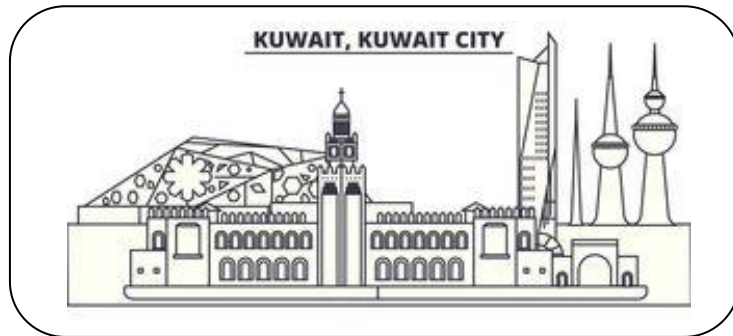
